The instructions for Oral and Poster Presentation are given below

1. Oral presentations

Each presenter is given 10 minutes to present their slide show, and 3 minutes for discussion and exchange with the audience, mediated by the chair and co-chair of the session.

Each presentation room is equipped with a laptop. All presenters are asked to use exclusively this system for their presentation. Please prepare your files on a USB key for transfer to the session room laptop. Presenters will not be allowed to disconnect the session room laptop and connect any other computers to the system. Thus, presenters are asked to prepare their presentations to be compatible with the system. Please check you presentation on these test laptops earlier to be sure not to disturb the time schedule of the Conference by incompatibility issues during their presentation in the session room. A session assistant will be there to help. Also inform your session assistant if you want your presentation to be removed from the laptop at the end of the session.

Sessions will start on time; the respect of the time schedule is essential to the success of the Conference. So, be sure to contribute to it with good preparation of your presentation. In case of any special needs, ask one of the volunteers for help; they will do their best to assist you.

2. Poster presentation

Sizing:

The size of poster should be 1-meter X 1 meter.

The volunteers, especially dedicated to help poster presenters, will be there to help you fixing your poster on the panel.
